

A Little Batty



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Size: approximately 8" X 8 ¼ ".

Materials: One skein of worsted weight cotton in a solid color. Approximately 88 yards. The cloth pictured was done in Peaches & Crème in Silver Gray.

Needles: U.S. Size 6/4.0mm or 5/3.75mm Because this is a “picture” cloth, you want your fabric to be fairly dense so the design will pop out. If you are a loose knitter, then you might want to drop down a needle size.

Gauge: 4.5 sts. per inch, not critical.

Abbreviations:

k = knit

p = purl

sts. = stitches

Pattern:

Cast on 37 stitches

Rows 1 – 8: (k_1, p_1) across row.

*Row 9: (right side) $(k_1, p_1) \times 4; k_7; p_1; k_{13}; (p_1, k_1) \times 4$.

Row 10: $(k_1, p_1) \times 3; k_1; p_{13}; k_1; p_8; k_2; (p_1, k_1) \times 3$.

Row 11: $(k_1, p_1) \times 4; k_9; p_1; k_{13}; (p_1, k_1) \times 3$.

Row 12: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_1; p_{13}; k_1; p_{10}; k_1; p_2; k_1; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 13: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_3; p_1; k_{10}; p_1; k_6; p_3; k_5; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 14: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_1; (p_2, k_2) \times 2; p_4; k_1; p_{11}; k_1; p_2; k_1; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 15: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_3; p_1; k_4; p_1; k_6; p_1; k_4; p_1; k_1; p_1; k_3; p_1; k_2; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 16: $(k_1, p_1) \times 3; k_1; p_6; k_1; p_2; k_1; p_{12}; k_1; p_2; k_1; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 17: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_3; p_1; k_{12}; p_1; k_1; p_1; k_6; p_1; k_3; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 18: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_1; p_3; k_1; p_4; k_1; p_1; k_1; p_{13}; k_1; p_2; k_1; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 19: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_3; p_1; k_{13}; (p_1, k_2) \times 2; p_1; k_5; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 20: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_1; p_4; k_1; p_5; k_1; p_{13}; k_1; p_2; k_1; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 21: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_4; p_1; k_{12}; p_1; k_4; p_1; k_6; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 22: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_1; p_5; k_1; p_4; k_1; p_{12}; k_1; p_3; k_1; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 23: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_5; p_1; k_{11}; p_1; k_4; p_1; k_6; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 24: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_1; p_5; k_3; p_2; k_1; p_{10}; k_1; p_5; k_1; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 25: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_7; p_1; k_9; p_1; k_1; p_1; k_9; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 26: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_1; p_9; k_4; p_6; k_1; p_7; k_1; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 27: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_7; p_3; k_4; p_1; k_4; p_2; k_8; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 28: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_1; p_6; k_1; p_7; k_5; p_2; k_1; p_5; k_1; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 29: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_6; p_1; k_5; p_1; k_9; p_1; k_6; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 30: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_1; p_4; k_1; p_5; k_3; p_2; k_1; p_4; k_1; p_1; k_1; p_4; k_1; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 31: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_5; p_1; k_2; p_1; k_3; p_1; k_2; p_1; k_7; p_2; k_4; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 32: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_1; p_2; k_1; p_1; k_1; p_7; k_1; p_2; k_1; p_6; k_1; p_4; k_1; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 33: $(k_1, p_1) \times 2; k_5; p_1; k_6; p_1; k_4; p_1; k_5; (p_1, k_2) \times 2; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 34: $(k_1, p_1) \times 3; k_1; p_2; k_1; p_3; k_1; p_6; k_2; p_5; k_1; p_4; k_1; (p_1, k_1) \times 2$.

Row 35: (k1, p1) x2; k5; p1; k4; p1; k1; p1; k10; (p1, k2) x2; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 36: (k1, p1) x3; k1; p2; k1; p6; k1; p3; k1; p2; k1; p4; k1; p3; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 37: (k1, p1) x2; k3; p1; k1; p1; k3; p1; k2; p1; k9; (p1, k1) x2; p1; k2; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 38: (k1, p1) x3; k2; p2; k1; p9; (k1, p2) x4; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 39: (k1, p1) x2; k3; p1; k5; p1; k3; p1; k8; p1; k3; p1; k2; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 40: (k1, p1) x2; (k1, p6) x2; k2; p3; k2; p4; k1; p2; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 41: (k1, p1) x2; (k3, p1) x2; k5; p1; k1; p1; k4; p1; k8; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 42: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p8; k4; p2; k1; p6; (k1, p2) x2; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 43: (k1, p1) x2; k3; p1; k1; p1; k7; p1; k2; p1; k12; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 44: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p11; k1; p2; k1; p8; k2; p2; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 45: (k1, p1) x2; k13; p1; k2; p1; k12; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 46: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p11; k1; p1; k1; p13; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 47: (k1, p1) x3; k13; p2; k10; (p1, k1) x3.

Row 48: (k1, p1) x3; k1; p9; k1; p13; k1; (p1, k1) x3.

Row 49: (k1, p1) x4; k21; (p1, k1) x4.

Row 50: (k1, p1) x4; k1; p19; k1; (p1, k1) x4.

Row 51: (k1, p1) x5; k17; (p1, k1) x5.

Rows 52 - 58: (k1, p1) across row.

Bind off in k1, p1 and weave in ends.



	Knit on odd numbered rows; purl on even numbered rows
X	Purl on odd numbered rows; knit on even numbered rows
