

## Cupcake



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**Size:** approximately 8  $\frac{3}{4}$ " X 7  $\frac{3}{4}$ ".

**Materials:** One skein of worsted weight cotton in a solid color. The cloth pictured was done in Peaches & Crème in Baby Pink.

**Needles:** U.S. Size 6/4.0mm or 5/3.75mm. Because this is a "picture" cloth, you want your fabric to be fairly dense so the design will pop out. If you are a loose knitter, then you might want to drop down a needle size.

**Gauge:** 4.5 sts. per inch, not critical.

### **Abbreviations:**

k = knit

p = purl

sts. = stitches

dec. = decrease

**Pattern:** Cast on 37 stitches

Rows 1 -6: k1, p1 across row.

Rows 7 **and** 8: (k1, p1) x2, k1, p3) x4; (k1, p1) x2; k1.

Row 9:  $k_1; p_1; k_1; p_2; k_4 (p_1, k_1, p_1, k_5) x_2; p_1; k_1; p_1; k_4; p_2; k_1; p_1; k_1$ .

Row 10:  $(k_1, p_1) x_2; k_1; p_5; (k_1, p_7)x_2; k_1; p_5; (k_1, p_1) x_2; k_1$ .

Row 11:  $(k_1, p_1) x_3; k_{25}; (p_1, k_1) x_3$ .

Row 12:  $(k_1, p_1) x_3; k_1; p_{23}; (k_1, p_1) x_3; k_1$ .

Row 13:  $(k_1, p_1) x_4; k_5; p_{11}; k_5; (p_1, k_1) x_4$ .

Row 14:  $(k_1, p_1) x_3; k_1; p_6; k_1; p_1; (k_1, p_2) x_2; k_1; p_1; k_1; p_6; (k_1, p_1) x_3; k_1$ .

Row 15:  $(k_1, p_1) x_3; k_7; p_1; k_1; (p_1, k_2) x_2; p_1, k_1; p_1; k_7; (p_1, k_1) x_3$ .

Row 16:  $(k_1, p_1) x_2; k_1; p_8; k_1; p_1; (k_1, p_2) x_2; k_1; p_1; k_1; p_8; (k_1, p_1) x_2; k_1$ .

Row 17:  $k_1; p_1; k_1; p_2; k_8; p_1; k_1; (p_1, k_2) x_2; p_1; k_1; p_1; k_8; p_2; k_1; p_1; k_1$ .

Row 18:  $(k_1, p_1) x_2; k_1; p_7; (k_1, p_2) x_4; k_1; p_7; (k_1, p_1) x_2; k_1$ .

Row 19:  $(k_1, p_1) x_3; k_6; (p_1, k_2) x_4; p_1; k_6; (p_1, k_1) x_3$ .

Row 20:  $(k_1, p_1) x_3; k_1; p_4; k_1; p_2; k_1; p_7; k_1; p_2; k_1; p_4; (k_1, p_1) x_3; k_1$ .

Row 21:  $(k_1, p_1) x_4; k_3; p_1; k_{13}; p_1; k_3; (p_1, k_1) x_4$ .

Row 22:  $(k_1, p_1) x_3; k_1; p_3; k_2; p_5; k_3; p_5; k_2; p_3; (k_1, p_1) x_3; k_1$ .

Row 23:  $(k_1, p_1) x_3; k_3; p_1; k_2; (p_1, k_3) x_3; p_1; k_2; p_1; k_3; (p_1, k_1) x_3$ .

Row 24:  $(k_1, p_1) x_2; k_1; p_4; k_1; p_3; k_3; p_5; k_3; p_3; k_1; p_4; (k_1, p_1) x_2; k_1$ .

Row 25:  $k_1; p_1; k_1; p_2; k_4; p_1; k_7; p_1; k_9; p_1; k_4; p_2; k_1; p_1; k_1$ .

Row 26:  $(k_1, p_1) x_2; k_1; p_4; k_1; p_1; k_1; p_{15}; k_1; p_4; (k_1, p_1) x_2; k_1$ .

Row 27:  $(k_1, p_1) x_3; k_3; p_1; k_2; p_1; k_7; p_1; k_6; p_1; k_3; (p_1, k_1) x_3$ .

Row 28:  $(k_1, p_1) x_3; k_1; p_3; k_1; p_{15}; k_1; p_3; (k_1, p_1) x_3; k_1$ .

Row 29:  $(k_1, p_1) x_4; k_2; p_1; k_4; p_1; k_7; (p_1, k_2)x_2; (p_1, k_1) x_4$ .

Row 30:  $(k_1, p_1) x_3; k_1; p_4; k_1, p_{13}; k_1, p_4; (k_1, p_1) x_3; k_1$ .

Row 31:  $(k_1, p_1) x_3; k_6; (p_1, k_5) x_2; p_1; k_6; (p_1, k_1) x_3$ .

Row 32:  $(k_1, p_1) x_2; k_1; p_8; k_1, p_9; k_1; p_8; (k_1, p_1) x_2; k_1;$

Row 33:  $k_1, p_1; k_1; p_2; k_9; p_9; k_9; p_2; k_1; p_1; k_1$ .

Row 34:  $(k_1, p_1) x_2; k_1; p_{11}; k_1; p_3; k_1; p_{11}; (k_1, p_1) x_2; k_1$ .

Row 35:  $(k_1, p_1) x_3; k_{10}; p_1; k_2; p_2; k_{10}; (p_1, k_1) x_3$ .

Row 36: (k1, p1) x3; k1; p9; (k1, p1)x2; k1; p9; (k1, p1) x3; k1.  
Row 37: (k1, p1) x4; k8; p2; k2; p1; k8; (p1, k1) x4.  
Row 38: (k1, p1) x3; k1; p9; k2; p2; k1; p9; (k1, p1) x3; k1.  
Row 39: (k1, p1) x3; k10; (p1, k1)x2; p1; k10; (p1, k1) x3.  
Row 40: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p11; k1; p2; k2; p11; (k1, p1) x2; k1.  
Row 41: k1; p1; k1; p2; k11; p1; k2; p2; k11; p2; k1; p1; k1.  
Row 42: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p11; (k1, p1) x2; k1; p11; (k1, p1) x2; k1.  
Row 43: (k1, p1) x3; k10; p2; k2; p1; k10; (p1, k1) x3.  
Row 44: (k1, p1) x3; k1; p10; k3; p10; (k1, p1) x3; k1.  
Row 45: (k1, p1) x4; k10; p1; k10; (p1, k1) x4.  
Row 46: (k1, p1) x3; k1; p11; k1; p11; (k1, p1) x3; k1.  
Row 47: (k1, p1) x3; k11; p3; k11; (p1, k1) x3.  
Row 48: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p12; k3; p12; (k1, p1) x2; k1.  
Row 49: k1; p1; k1; p2; k12; p3; k12; p2; k1, p1; k1.  
Row 50: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p12; k3; p12; (k1, p1) x2; k1.  
Row 51: (k1, p1) x3; k11; p2; k12; (p1, k1) x3.  
Row 52: (k1, p1) x3; k1; p11; k1; p11; (k1, p1) x3; k1.  
Row 53: (k1, p1) x4; k10; p1; k10; (p1, k1) x4.  
Row 54: (k1, p1) x3; k1; p23; (k1, p1) x3; k1.  
Row 55: (k1, p1) x3; k25; (p1, k1) x3.  
Row 56: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p5 (k1, p7) x2; k1; p5; (k1, p1) x2; k1.  
Row 57: k1; p1; k1; p2; k4; (p1, k1, p1, k5) x2; p1; k1; p1; k4; p2; k1; p1; k1.  
Rows 58 **and** 59: (k1, p1) x2; k1, p3) x4; (k1, p1) x2; k1.  
Rows 60 – 64: (k1, p1) across row.  
Bind off in k1, p1 ribbing and weave in ends.

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	Knit on odd numbered rows; purl on even numbered rows
<b>X</b>	Purl on odd numbered rows; knit on even numbered rows
